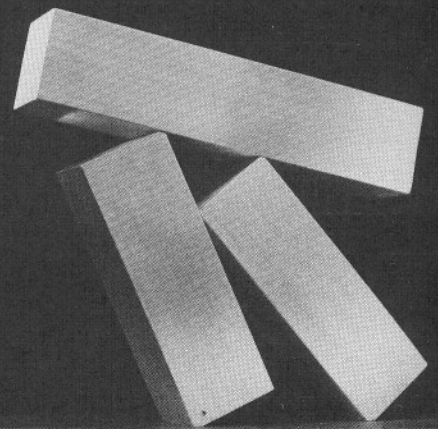

1981 is a year of particular note for both Japan and Canada. This year, the Hakone Open Air Museum in Tokyo, Japan, invited Kosso, representing Canada, to submit a sculpture to their **2nd Henry Moore Grand Prize International Competition**. It was his submission, "Zen-West 81" in stainless steel (10' x 10' x 2'), that succeeded in winning the special distinction prize. The piece was also acquired by the Museum for its permanent collection.

Conceived in an exclusive edition of two, the second copy of "Zen-West 81", which is privileged to share in the honours bestowed upon its identical twin in Japan, is now being made available here in Canada through Gallery Quan.
